

## **Blue Eye Variation of a premises licence**

**Recorded music (indoors) Monday to Sunday 12.00pm to 1.00am**

**Sale of alcohol (on and off the premises) Monday to Sunday 12.00pm to 1.00am**

The City of Durham Parish Council Licensing Committee discussed this application at their meeting on the 12th July 2019 and while they could see no reason to object to the first part of the variation it was considered that the second part could constitute a public nuisance as it was associated with a pavement licence for street furniture outside the premises.

Given that the other licensed premises on Elvet Bridge brings in its outside seating at 11pm the committee felt that it would not be unreasonable to ask for a 11pm curfew on Blue Eye.

Accordingly the Chair contacted Matt Foster of Mincoffs, solicitors for the applicant, to ask if Mr Koroglu (the applicant) would be agreeable to this condition and received the reply attached.

We would therefore like the following conditions (as laid out by Mr Foster) to be placed on the licence.

1. Off sales from the premises will cease at 11pm
2. Use of the pavement café will cease at 11pm and the outside seating will not be used after this time.
