With reference to the above Licensing application, the City of Durham Parish Council wishes to object to this application on the following grounds:

### The prevention of crime and disorder

The Parish Council feels that it is necessary that a condition be applied to this license that the premises has door security staff on all days of operation, particularly on Wednesday evenings as this is traditionally the evening where a high volume of students attend licensed premises in Durham City.

### Public safety

The Parish Council notes that this application proposes outdoor seating as part of this application. The Parish Council is concerned at the proposed seating outside the premises blocking an area used by members of the public as a walk through and feel that a revised scheme needs to be devised to overcome any accessibility issues.

### The prevention of public nuisance

The Parish Council notes that this application is wishing to sell alcohol off the premises and proposes outdoor seating as part of this application. The Parish Council feels that seating outside should only be permitted up until 9pm on all evenings to avoid any outside noise caused by drinking off premises causing a nuisance to nearby residential properties. The Parish Council also feels that the tipping of glass bottles should not be permitted between the hours of 9pm – 8am.
